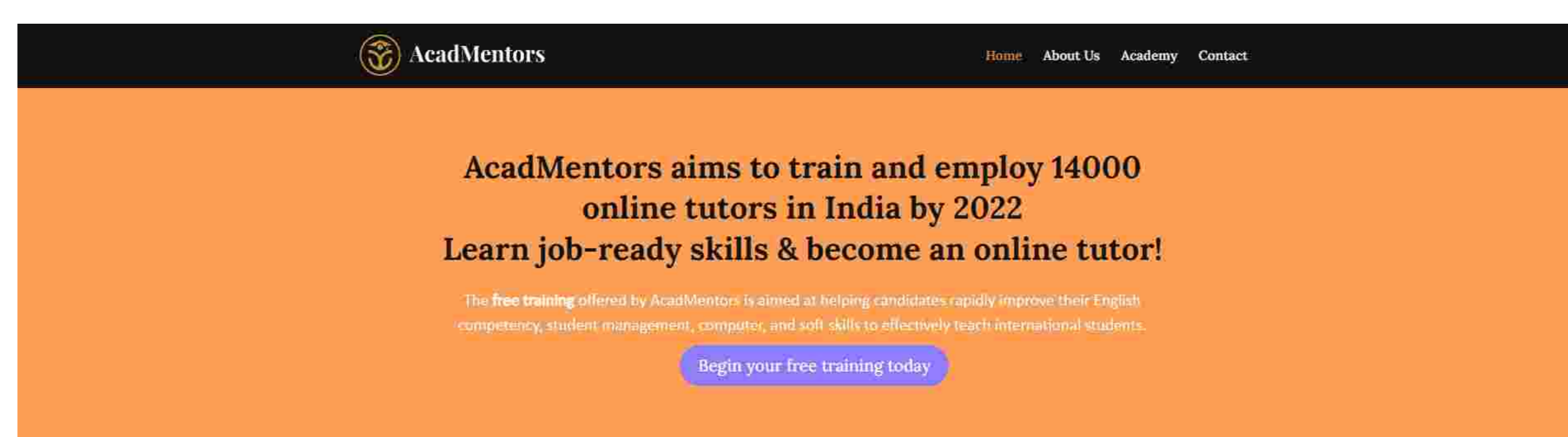


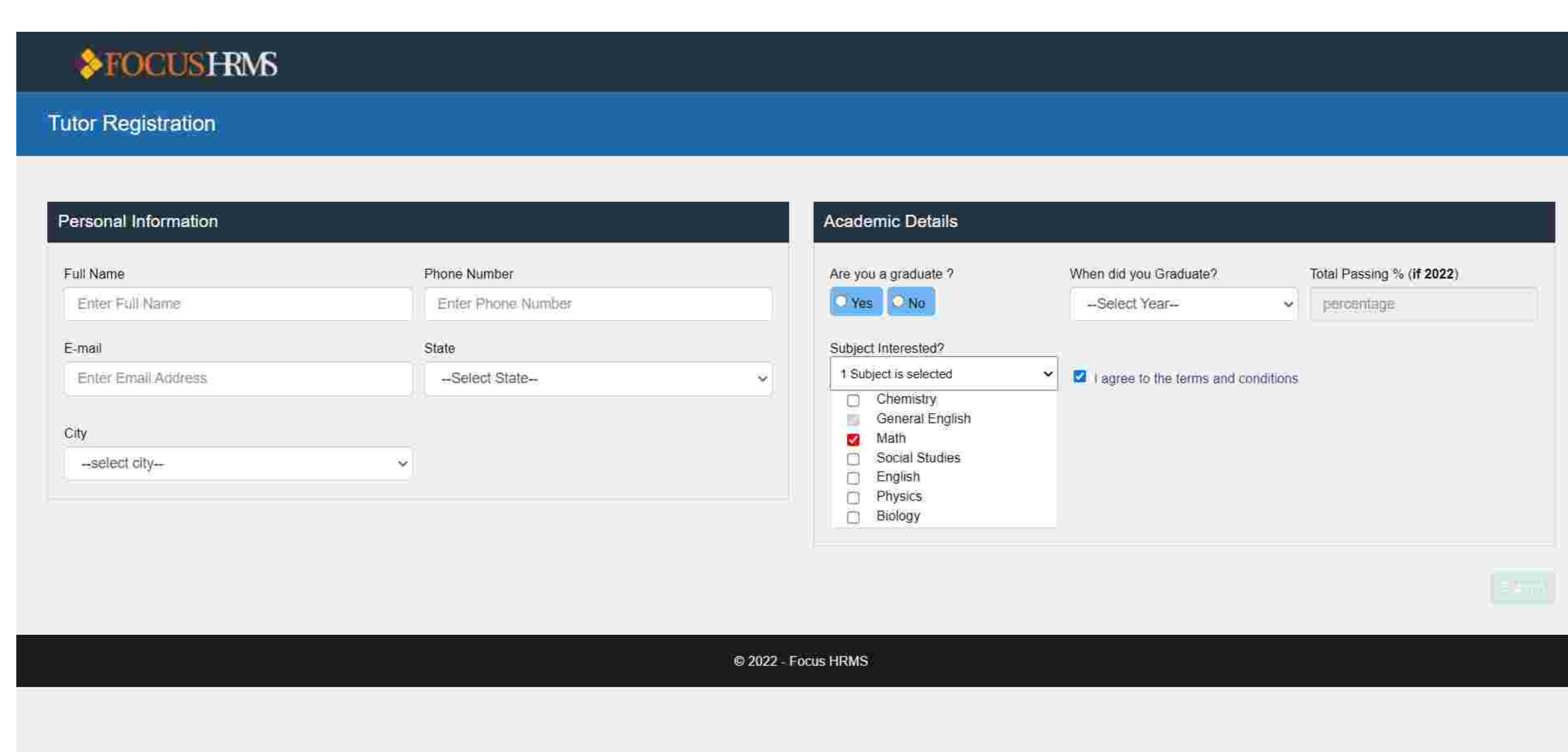
Your Step-By-Step Guide to the Screening Test

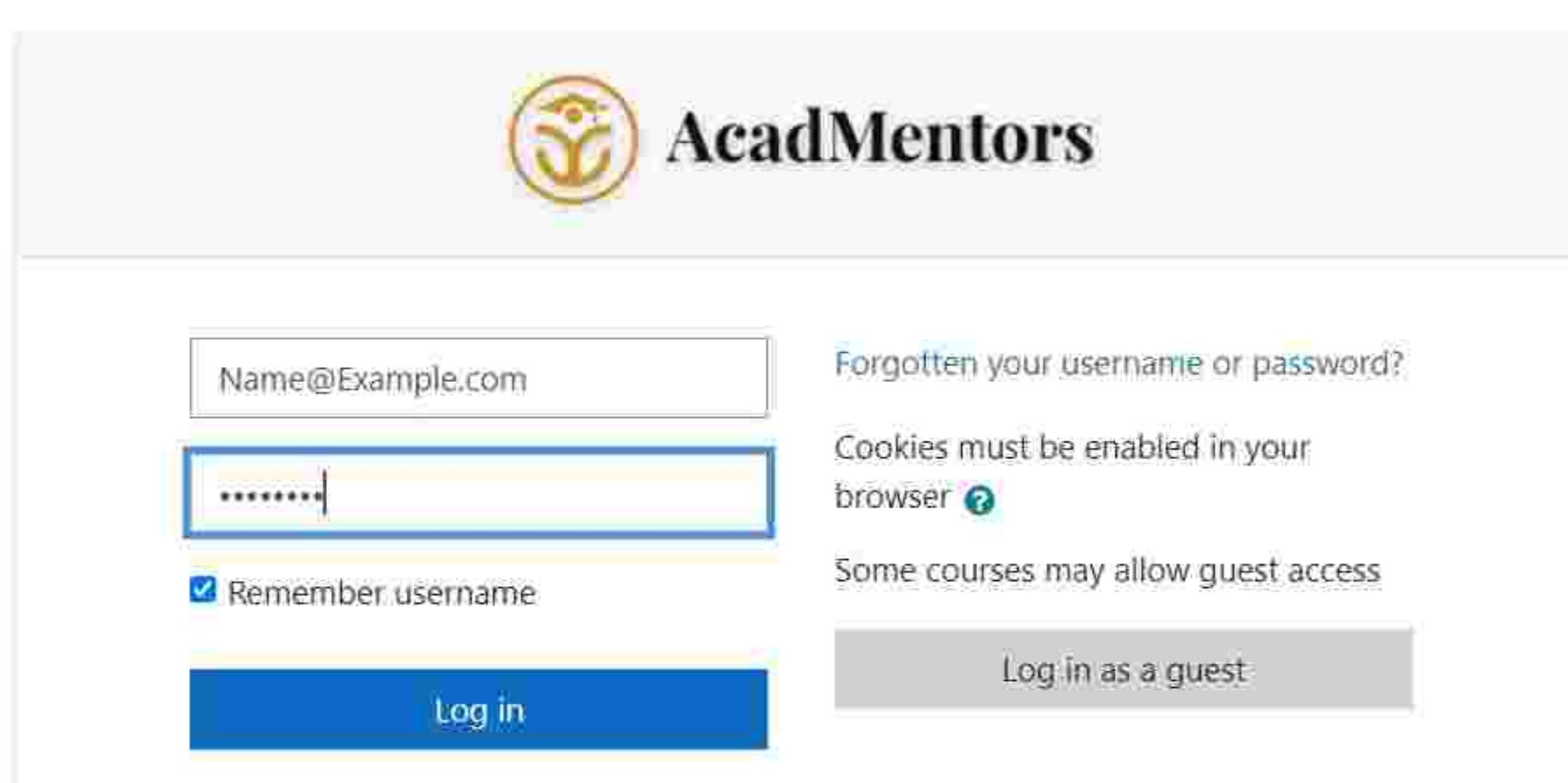
Click on the "Begin your free training" to get started with your screening test



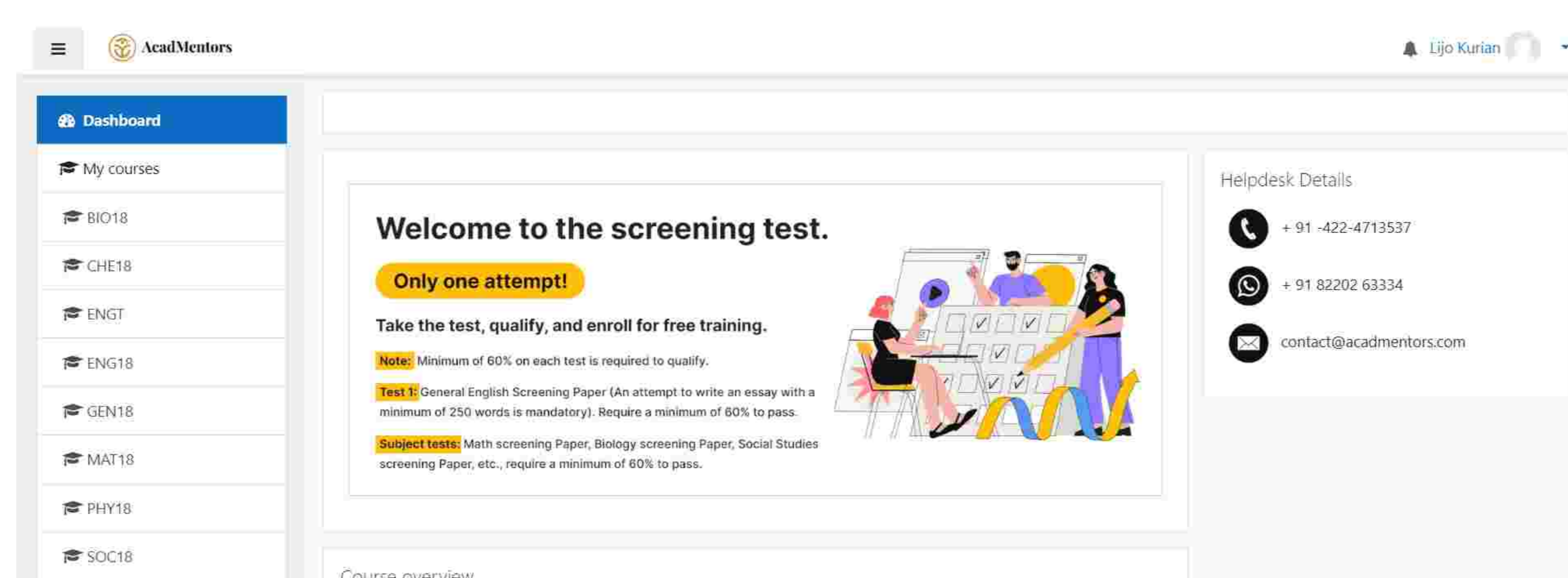
On landing on the "Tutor Registration" page, applicants have to fill in the required information. Filling in the correct email and phone number is vital as this will be used for future communication. Applicants should select the subject(s) they are interested in teaching in the "Subjects interested" column. (Note: Every applicant must take the General English test by default. Of the other six subjects offered, they may select one or more if they are interested. By clicking on "I agree to the terms & conditions & Submit," the applicant will receive the credentials to the registered email address to log into the LMS.



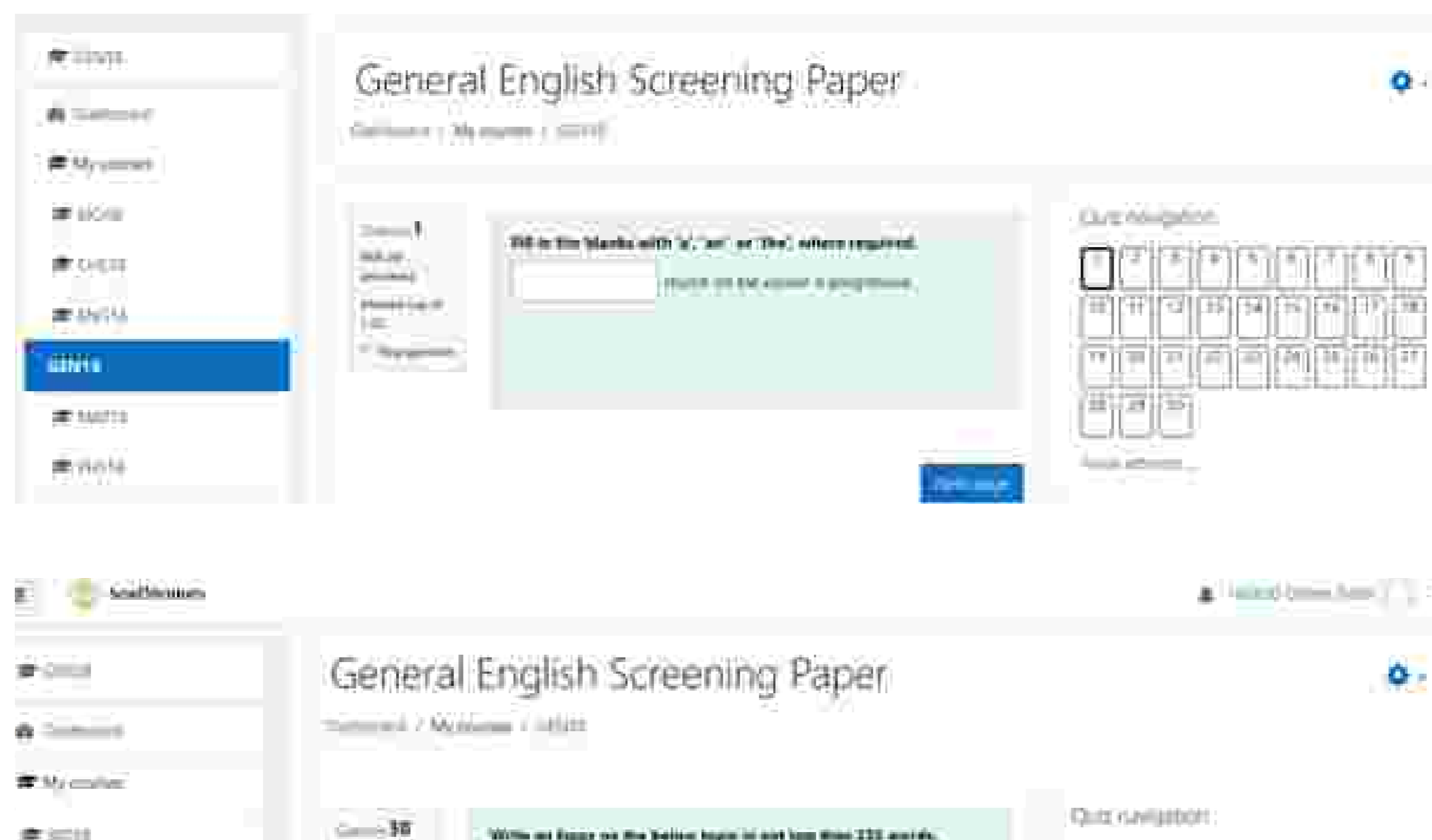
Using the credentials received on the registered email, applicants can access the LMS and proceed with the test.



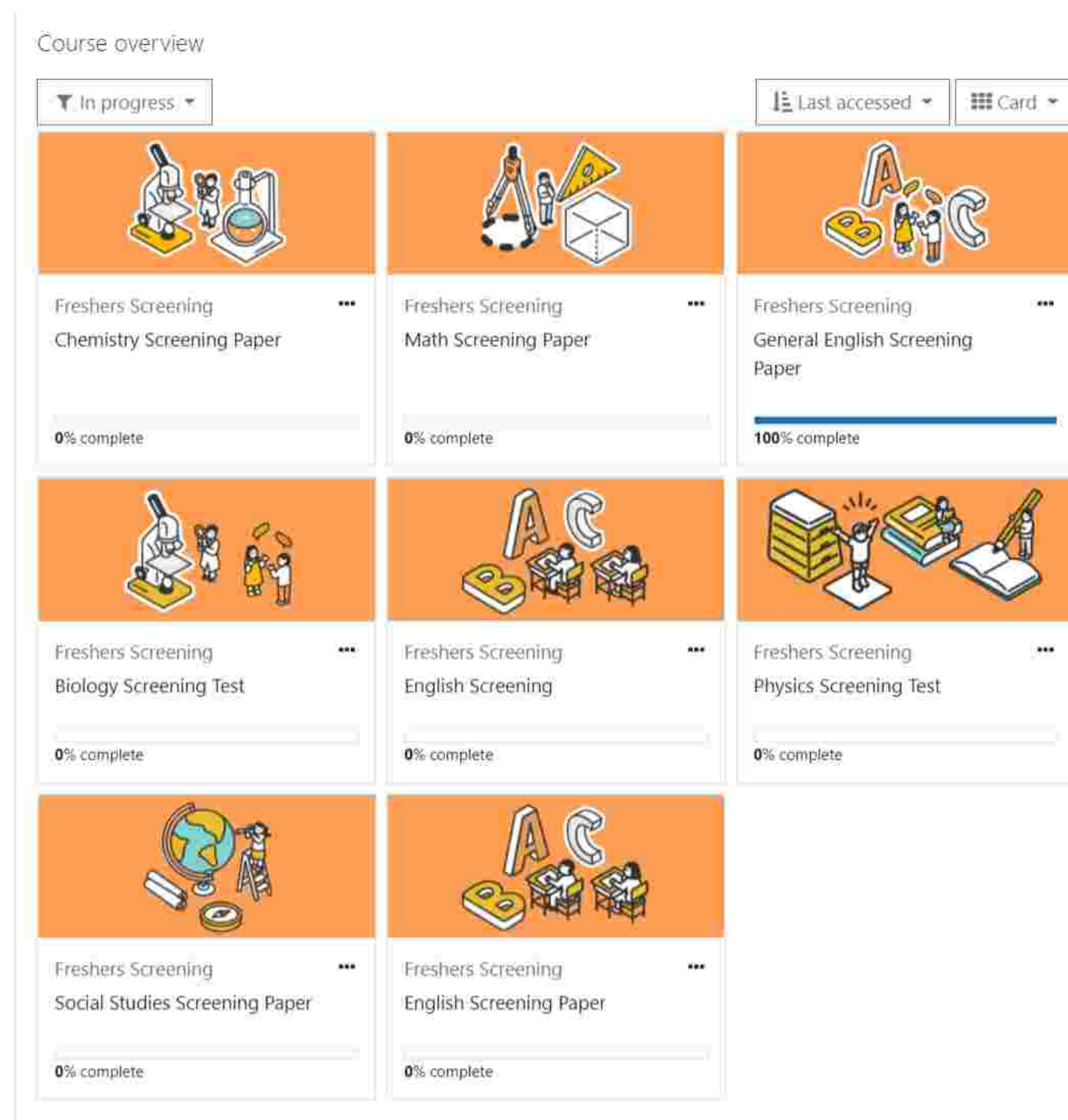
The LMS will list down the subject(s) preferred for test on the dashboard "My courses"



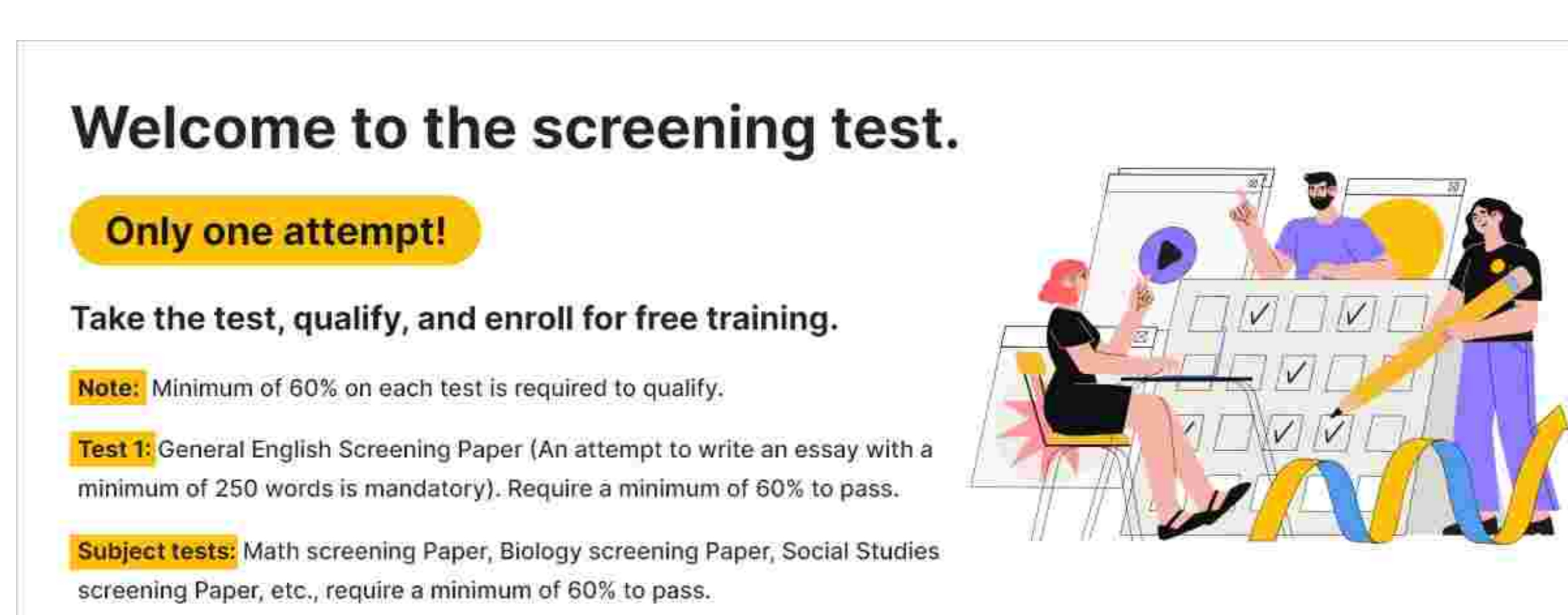
An essay and multiple-choice questions will be part of the "General English assessment," a mandatory test. To pass the test and be evaluated, applicants must submit an essay with a minimum of 250 words.



The subject(s) selected will appear on the LMS dashboard and by clicking on it, applicants can complete the test.



Important note a minimum of 60% is required to qualify for each test. For English (MCQs+Essay=60%), For subject test (60%). Only one attempt is permitted, so carefully read the questions before responding
